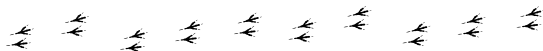

GENERAL INFORMATION

This summer The University of Iowa Recreational Services will sponsor Peregrinatio per Iowam, (Latin for "a wandering journey through Iowa"). These traveling Wildlife Camps will be offered for those who are going to be high school freshmen and sophomores. These trips will focus on the wildlife and natural history of northeast and central Iowa. Participants will be transported by van. We will leave The University of Iowa Hawkeye Recreation Fields Complex at 8:30 a.m. And return from the 3-day trip around 4:15 p.m. Additional brochures can be obtained from Recreational Services at 319-335-9293.

REGISTRATION

Students may register by mail beginning on Monday, May 4, 2009. All applicants must include a letter by the camper stating why he/she would like to attend Peregrinatio per Iowam and what they hope to learn. A teacher reference, with a phone number, is also required. The trip is limited to sixteen students. When the trip is filled, a waiting list will be established. A non-refundable deposit of \$75.00 is required. The remainder of the fee is due one business week before the trip begins. A confirmation letter and health form will be mailed to each participant after they are registered. The health form must be completed and included with the final payment. A detailed map to the Hawkeye Recreation Fields Complex (Hawkeye Park Drive) will be provided with the confirmation letter.

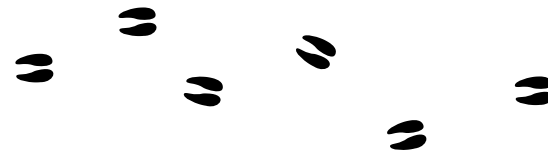
