## CO-REC INTRAMURAL CHAMPIONSHIP POINT SYSTEM

Points are awarded to each team that participates in intramural sports. Teams are awarded points based upon their finish in a sport with a minimum number of points guaranteed to each participating team. The categories are as follows:

CATEGORY	POINTS	SPORT
I [5 week season + tournament]	50 - 150	Flag Football Basketball
II [shorter season + tournament]	50 - 125	Volleyball Indoor Soccer Softball
III [large team events]	40 - 100	6-on-6 Sand Volleyball Dodgeball** Kickball* Wrestling* Wiffleball* Ultimate*
IV [smaller team events**]	25 - 75	Golf Doubles Tennis Bowling** Mini-Golf Doubles Badminton Doubles Table Tennis Doubles Billiards Doubles Darts 4-on-4 Sand Volleyball Disc Golf**

**NOTE: In order to accumulate Intramural Championship Points, teams need to keep the same team name throughout the year.**

\* Kickball, Wrestling, Wiffleball, and Ultimate are open events. In order to receive Co-Rec Intramural Championship Points for these events, it must be indicated on the entry form at the time of sign-up. These teams must have at least 2 males and 2 females signed-in and participating in each game that the team plays.

\*\* In four-person open events such as Bowling and Disc Golf, two participants must be male and two must be female in order to be considered for Co-Rec points. In open doubles events and Dodgeball, the team must consist of at least one male and one female to be considered for Co-Rec points.
